ELIGIBILITY

- A candidate for graduation from West Genesee High School
- Candidate must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution (includes two and four year institutions and trade schools)

CRITERIA

- Demonstrate leadership ability with an emphasis on teamwork oriented qualities
- Prove how you have helped or given back to others
- Describe involvement in extracurricular activities (school, community, work or familial participation)

PROCEDURE

- Attached application must be submitted with the above requirements by April 15, 2023 to wg14foundation@gmail.com.
- Two letters of recommendation (from those other than relatives) must be submitted to wg14foundation@gmail.com by April 20, 2023.
- All questions must be answered completely.
- Include a copy of your high school transcript and resume. Your resume should reflect school and community activities, as well as any awards and recognition you have received in these activities.
- Finalists may be interviewed by the selection committee in early May.
- Scholarship will be awarded by end of May 2023.
- All scholarships awarded will be paid directly to your educational institution.

EDUCATION POSTPONEMENT

If the winner chooses to postpone their college education, the scholarship may be reserved for up to one year from the date of graduation.
